

2021 Pinot Noir, Sonoma Coast 12.9% abv Four barrels produced

Vineyards:

- Saccomanno Vineyard (75%)
 - Green Valley of the Russian River Valley
 - Organically (uncertified) farmed by hand
 - Goldridge sandy-loam soils
 - 200 feet above sea level
 - 12 miles from the Pacific Ocean
- Grand Vent Vineyard (25%)
 - Western Petaluma Gap
 - Organically (uncertified) farmed by hand
 - Blucher Loam soils
 - 240 feet above sea level
 - 11 miles from the Pacific Ocean

Winemaking:

- Hand-sorted, 65% whole cluster
- Native primary fermentation, natural malolactic conversion
- Aged 10 months in neutral French Oak
- Bottled unfiltered, <65ppm TSO2
