Our inaugural "WestPet" Pinot Noir comprises two hyper-coastal sites in far west Petaluma. Extreme diurnal shifts, intense winds, dense marine fog and water stress create low yields and small, densely flavored clusters that achieve full ripeness at moderate sugar levels while maintaining bright, natural acidity.
